

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

OHIO-MICHIGAN SUMMER SWIM LEAGUE

The Ohio-Michigan Summer Swim League, heretofore referred to as OMSSL, is the governing and organizing body for an association of summer swimming facilities located in the Northwest Ohio and Southeast Michigan area for the specific purpose of coordinating and supervising competitive swim meets and a championship day amongst these facilities.

The OMSSL operates during the months of May through August exclusively. The OMSSL has at least three meetings during this time or organize and distribute the necessary supplies for these activities as well as decide on the rules for the meets. They also hire and /or contract for the supplies and services needed for the activities under their auspices.

The OMSSL while autonomous operates solely for the purpose of regulating the competitive swimming activities of the member facilities which support it. As of this date, June 1, 1998, these facilities are:

The OMSSL has a minimum of three officers each year and preferably seven officers depending on the availability of volunteers. These officers are unpaid volunteers representing the clubs associated with the OMSSL. Additional members of the OMSSL Board are also outlined below.

The President or Chairperson organizes the meetings and presides over same.

The Past President or Co-Chairperson is to assume the Chairperson's duties when he or she subsequently retires from that office.

The Vice-President purchases and distributes paperwork i.e. heat sheets, disqualification cards, etc. and ribbons and medals for the swim meets and Championship meet. He or she also stands in for the President when that person is not available.

The Secretary records all meeting minutes and takes care of all correspondence related to OMSSL activities. He or she also supervises the printing of Heat Sheets for Championships.

The Champs Director takes care of all Championship meet responsibilities acquiring U.S.S. Official(s), suckers, porta-potties, toilet paper, hand sanitizer, etc., all items necessary for Championships to run smoothly.

The Treasurer takes care of all finances, pays bills and does yearly balance sheets for the final meeting each year.

The Recorder keeps track of all swimmers' names and addresses, checks for appropriate birthdates and records times and tracks OMSSL Event Records.

Additional members of the OMSSL Board include the swim team coaches from each club and additional representatives of each club i.e. managers as they attend the meetings.

Members of the Board are appointed by the President or the consensus of the Board.

The Member Clubs of the OMSSL are admitted at the discretion of the OMSSL Board without regard to race, creed or color but based solely on the purpose of Club requesting admission, i.e. for the purpose of promoting competitive swimming during the summer months in a relaxed atmosphere.

The OMSSL derives its financial support through its collection of a League Fee of \$100.00 per club per year and the additional fee of \$6.00 per swimmer. Additional funds are raised through the sale of T-shirts and refreshments at the Championship Swim Meet. These fees can change as the need arises and at the discretion of the Board of OMSSL.
